A ticket to the dinner will be provided to each exhibitor, and a ticket for the farm's trainer named on your entry form, who is not also an exhibitor. Additional tickets can be requested, the additional number you need <u>must</u> be indicated on your entry form. Additional tickets will <u>not</u> be available at the show. Tickets will be mailed to you with your passes, and a ticket <u>must</u> be presented to attend the party. Check out all the divisions and enter as many classes as possible. It's a busy, fun weekend for you, your horse, and your family and friends who come to cheer for you!

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Gate 1 is the Entrance Gate for the Horse Show. Arrival will be allowed no earlier than 10:00 AM, Thursday August 3, 2023, for admission to the grounds, departing no later than 7:00 PM, Sunday, August 6, 2023.

Early arrivals on Wednesday, August 2, 2023 will be by appointments only. Please contact Terri Handy at 603-313-4733. If you drop off camper/trailer and you have not contacted Terri your rig will be <u>TOWED</u>.

EMT/First-aid, food and water are available on the Fairgrounds. There will be a veterinarian on call and a farrier will be on the grounds. No bedding will be provided. Bedding **WILL NOT** be sold on the grounds.

CAMPERS: There is space for campers, however, limited hook-ups are available and will be on a first come, first serve basis. A camper fee of \$40 per night or /\$120 for the weekend hook-up will be charged with an additional fee of \$20 for slide out/awnings or trailers/campers over 32' long. Reservations must be made at the time of entry. All horse trailers being used for tack stalls will be charged \$90. All trailers being used as sleeping quarters with no hook -ups will be charged \$10 from Thurs. to Sun. If sleeping in the trailer on Wednesday night, add an extra \$10.00 fee. All horse trailers not being used for tack rooms or camping MUST be moved to the overflow parking area. Dumping station on the grounds available for \$35.00 fee (per dump). No Camper may be brought in after 6:00 PM on Thursday evening, August 4, 2023.

- 1. NH State Law NO GRAY WATER will be drained on the ground \$200 fine will be imposed.
- 2. Due to limited power and water, we strongly suggest that you fill your freshwater tank before you arrive on the show grounds.
- Anyone with a hose hooked up to CFA water supply is responsible for having and installing a back flow devise to prevent back siphoning at the fixture and will be subject to inspection.

CLASS SPONSORSHIPS: We welcome individuals, stables and businesses to sponsor classes. When you sponsor a class, your name, stable or business can be announced during the class. RABIES STATEMENT: All domestic animals entering the Cheshire Fair grounds must be inoculated for rabies before July 1, 2023. Exhibitors must be able to provide proof of inoculation if requested to do so. Proof must include the state in which the inoculation was given, the date inoculation was given, name of animals(s) and name of person giving the inoculation. Submission of the enclosed entry form guarantees that the exhibitor has read and complied with the rabies policy. Exhibitors are asked to be careful not to allow animals to bite or salivate on patrons.

2023 PASS POLICY

Two (2) exhibitor passes per horse and one (1) parking pass per vehicle towing a horse trailer will be issued with no exceptions! All passenger vehicles will need to park in free general parking on the hill. All extra passes will need to be purchased. Passes will be mailed to the name requested on the entry form. It is your responsibility to connect with this person to obtain your passes. **Passes will not be mailed after 7/28/2023.** Post entry passes will be held at Gate 1. If you do not have your pass at Gate 1 upon arrival, be prepared to purchase passes at that time. NO EXCEPTIONS!

NO PASS = NO ADMITTANCE! No refund on purchased passes will be given inside the gate.

STABLING INFORMATION

Stalls: Stabling is provided through permanent stalls, as well as temporary stalls. You may reserve horse stalls at \$80 per stall by filling out the appropriate information on your entry form. Tack stalls will be charged \$90. Exhibitors will be charged for every stall they use. All parties wishing to be stabled together should mail their entries together and complete a block stabling request on the back side of one entry. **NO STALLS will be reserved without payment or signed blank check.** Accurate completion of your stabling reservation form is of prime importance in assuring your reserved stabling!

Trailers used for tack will be charged \$90. Exhibitors hauling in and working out of their trailers will be charged a \$20 trailer/truck fee per day.

Bedding IS NOT being sold on the grounds. Bedding can be purchased locally through the Cheshire Horse. Please contact them before Monday, August 1, 2023, at (603) 358-3001 to pre-purchase bedding and arrange for delivery to the fairgrounds.

Exhibitors may not arrive on Thursday before 10:00 AM, and no later than 6:00 PM. Contact Terri Handy, at 603-313-4733, if you have any questions.

DAY STALLS: Day stalls, if available, will be on a first come first serve basis at \$35 per day. Please call Terri Handy at (603)313-4733 if you would like to find out more information on day stalls.

Exhibitors are asked to use common sense stabling their horse(s). Proper and humane care of the animals is expected while stabling on the grounds. Stall checks may be done at any time by the fair personnel and any problem affecting the animal's welfare will be addressed and remedied (i.e. horse tied out of reach of water).

SHOW RULES

The Cheshire Fair Association, Cheshire Fairgrounds, NHH&TA, and Show Management and all show personnel will not be responsible for any accidents, injury and/or loss of property that may occur to any animal, person or property and each exhibitor shall not hold them liable and indemnify them against any legal proceedings.

This show will be conducted under the rules of New Hampshire Horse and Trail Association.

Pre-entries close July 28, 2023. Entries post marked after July 28, 2023 shall be charged a one-time post entry fee of \$20 per entry. Passes will not be mailed after July 28, 2023. Post entry passes will be held at Horse Show Gate which will be Gate 1 off Safford Drive.

- Post entries will be accepted for classes in the morning session until 6:00
 PM the day before the session. Post entries for the afternoon and evening
 sessions will be accepted until one (1) hour before the start of the session.
- 2. There will be a NHH&TA fee of \$3 per horse for the first class entered. There will be an office fee of \$10 per horse.
- 3. There will be a \$25 charge for accounts that are not closed at the end of the show.
- 4. A fee of \$30 will be assessed for any check returned for "Insufficient Funds". A paperwork processing fee of \$20 will be charged to any exhibitor that sends in an entry and is a "no Show" the day of the show.
- 5. Damage to stalls will incur charges. Following is the breakout for those charges: Portable Stalls: Door vinyl panels (2 per door) \$100 per panel. Plywood wall damage is \$100 each panel. Permanent Stalls: per stall \$50 damage (walls, door, hardware, etc.)
- 6. Cancellation after the official start of the show means forfeit of entry fees, stall and camper fees, except in the case of an accident to horse or rider. Veterinarian/physician's certificate is required.
- 7. The management reserves the right to decline any entry or request the removal of any entry or person on the grounds.
- 8. The management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class or change judging assignments in cases of emergency.

- 9. Out of state horses must be accompanied by evidence of a negative Coggins test.
- 10. Holds will be granted at the discretion of the Management. Management will try to cooperate with any exhibitor requesting a hold but will not be responsible if a hold is not honored. If a hold is granted, the in gate will be held for two (2) minutes, then opened for two (2) minutes before the class is closed. Holds must be requested at least one (1) session before the class you want held.
- 11. In all classes open to registered animals only, the proper registration name and number must be listed on the entry blank and owners must be prepared to show registration papers to show officials.
- 12. Six (6) places will be pinned in all classes unless otherwise stated. Prize money will be awarded as listed under each class.
- 13. Classes must be paid for in advance or a signed blank check must be left with the show secretary.
- 14. NO SMOKING is allowed in the barn/stable area.
- 15. Exhibitors are responsible for damage incurred by them or their horse(s) to barns, show ring or other buildings on the grounds.
- 16. All dogs must remain leashed and in the barn area or the owner will be fined \$50.
- 17. The management is not responsible for errors or omissions in the published class list.
- 18. An unruly or unsound horse may be excused at the judge's discretion and the decision of the judge will be final.
- **19.** No stallions in ladies or junior classes.

NHH&TA will support the USEF and/or any affiliated state organization in any disciplinary action against exhibitors which involves sportsmanship or the good conduct of shows or indebtedness and will extend actions to all NHH&TA Affiliated Shows.




